**Course Description:** The Advanced Endovascular Training Course was created to allow Vascular Surgeons repetitive progressive Hands-On Training for all aspects of complex catheter interventions and endovascular stent grafts.

**Phase I:** This initial three day instructional assessment course lays the foundation for the series through:

- Extensive didactic discussions of device use, techniques, complex case management, and the management of endovascular complications
- Dry Lab Training featuring a wide array of devices and in depth discussion of benefits and limitations.
- Simulator Training
- Animal Lab Training with training on PTA, stenting and progressing to carotid, renal, visceral vessel and microcatheter embolization

**Phase II:** This Hands-On physician directed training maximizes the participant's educational experience by returning to NYPH for multiple two day courses progressing to the most complex interventions. This allows increased exposure and practical experience to fulfill home institution credentialing requirements.
